Buprenorphine X-Waiver Training Webinars Offered

Registration is open for buprenorphine x-waiver training webinars sponsored by the Wisconsin Society of Addiction Medicine and the Wisconsin Department of Health Services.

These webinars are part of an effort to expand the prescribing of buprenorphine, a medication used to treat opioid use disorder. The courses are open to MDs, DOs, NPs and PAs. Registration is required. There is no registration fee for the webinars.
