The Wisconsin Partisan Primary Election is **next week, Tuesday, Aug. 9**. WHA's grassroots advocacy program, the Hospitals Education & Advocacy Team (HEAT), reminds you to make your voice heard and VOTE in this upcoming primary election.

Individuals who are registered can vote absentee in-person at their municipal clerk's office **now through Sunday, Aug. 7**. Otherwise, individuals can register and vote in-person on Election Day, Tuesday, August 9 at their local polling location.
