Borgerding Presents at WHIMA Annual Conference; Mueller Receives WHIMA Award

The Wisconsin Health Information Management Association (WHIMA) held their 88th annual conference May 17-19, 2023, in Wisconsin Dells. One of most highly anticipated presentations every year is that by WHA President and CEO Eric Borgerding. Borgerding presented on the "State of Wisconsin Health Care" where he covered such topics as health care costs, including the impact of prior authorizations and insurance denials; the health care workforce and the importance of growing our own and removing regulatory barriers; the post-acute care bottleneck and subsequent community impact; and price transparency federal mandates.
