Grassroots Spotlight: Froedtert Menomonee Falls Hospital Hosts Roundtable with U.S. Rep. Scott Fitzgerald

WHA joined Congressman Scott Fitzgerald on June 22 for a health care roundtable hosted by Froedtert Menomonee Falls Hospital. The group thanked Fitzgerald for his efforts working with the Trump Administration and the rest of the Wisconsin Congressional Delegation to ensure Wisconsin's Medicaid program would be grandfathered at the higher level approved in the most recent State Budget. The group also discussed important issues such as the 340B prescription drug discount program, prior authorization and a request for relief from the \$100,000 fees for new H1-B Visas for health care workers.
