The bipartisan Wisconsin Senate and Assembly health committee chairs and co-chairs have invited their peers in the Legislature to attend a virtual briefing by WHA on Wisconsin's Health Care Workforce on Thursday, Aug. 27, from 10 – 11:15 a.m.

As WHA members know, the Wisconsin Hospital Association (WHA) produces an annual workforce report that has become a relied-upon guide for public policymakers and industry stakeholders. WHA's 2026 Wisconsin Health Care Workforce Report includes recommendations for health care employers, educators and public policymakers on how they can best support a health care workforce that meets the needs of patients in Wisconsin.
