Wisconsin Hospitals State PAC & Conduit — One Day Left to Contribute

\$1,717 remaining to reach the \$350,000 goal

There is just one day left to contribute to the 2025 Wisconsin Hospitals State PAC & Conduit campaign, and the finish line is in sight.

Thanks to strong participation from 230 hospital leaders across the state, the campaign has raised \$348,283—99% of the \$350,000 goal. With only \$1,717 remaining, final contributions will determine whether the campaign closes at goal when it officially ends Dec. 31.
